Dear Parents and Carers

As some of the government restrictions around the COVID-19 pandemic begin to be relaxed, we're starting to plan for how we'll be able to return to face-to-face activities at the 1st Beaumaris Sea Scout Group in the future.

We're all looking forward to being able to return, so I wanted to provide an update on how we're approaching the restart. Our restarting plans will follow all government rules as well as guidance from Scouts' UK headquarters. Our priority, as always, is to keep young people and adults safe.

Scouts have introduced a 'COVID Code':

- New control measures will be in place for all activities
- Additional hygiene measures will be put in place
- Social distancing will be observed
- Group sizes will be limited
- Adjustments will be made for young people vulnerable to or affected by COVID

Returning to Scouts will happen in phases, the first of which will let us resume outdoor activities in small groups. Returning to face-to-face Scouts is voluntary for all young people, parents/carers and volunteers.

We'll share more detailed plans for the new safety measures we're putting in place soon, and we'd encourage all parents and carers, young people and volunteers to raise concerns, ask questions and provide feedback.
